What are the benefits of Gift Aid?

You can make your donation worth an extra 28p for every pound given. Your money goes further at no cost to you.

How do I know if I can sign a Gift Aid form?

- You need to be a UK Taxpayer.
- You need to pay an amount of income tax (from a job) or capital gains tax (eg from savings) at least equal to the tax that we reclaim in that tax year.

What if my situation changes?

- If you no longer meet the requirements we can cancel your gift aid for any gifts made after the date of the cancellation.
- If you change address just inform us.

What if I am a higher rate taxpayer?

You can reclaim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return. You can ask for this money to also be sent to Crosslinks by quoting our reference, VAD 75XG.

What if you have signed a form for Crosslinks already?

It may be that we have a Gift Aid form for you that only covers some of your donations. If this is the case then we will not be able to reclaim tax on all of your gifts unless you are able to sign a form that covers all relevant gifts. There is not a limit on the number of forms that you can sign.

What about couples who give?

If both are taxpayers please both sign separate forms. If only one qualifies please send all donations from that person in the future. Please note that this will effect who your letters are addressed to.

What if you can't sign a Gift Aid form?

Please inform us so that we can mark this on our records.

What if the donation was/is to support a close relative?

There are special rules about reclaiming Gift Aid on donations given to support a close relative. Please contact the Accounts Department at Crosslinks if you need assistance on 020 8691 6111.
